CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS JUNE, 1938.

Ottawa, Canada, August 5, 1938. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for June, 1938, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for June, 1938 amounted to 94,144 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of June, 1938, 4,397,902 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,542,258 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, all grains—oats, corn, barley, buckwheat and mixed grain, were higher than for June last year.

Grains ground for the month of June, 1938 are shown in bushels with comperative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 4,397,902 (4,542,258); Oats 688,291 (639,628); Corn 389,359 (274,441); Barley 77,166 (71,977); Buckwheat 6,228 (3,539); and Mixed Grain 861,330 (616,808).

Mill stocks of wheat on June 30, 1938 amounted to 1,838,035 bushels, while for the same month in 1937 the amount was 3,474,532 bushels.

Flour production in June, 1938 amounted to 969,207 berrels compared with 1,000,879 berrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in June, 1938 amounted to 299,503 barrels compared with 389,995 barrels in June, 1937.

Flour production for the month of June, 1938 amounted to 969,207 barrels compared with 1,000,879 barrels for the same month last year. The decline was normal at this season, the second last month of the present crop year. Wheat offal was generally lower in keeping with the flour trend, middling alone varying. The items were bran, 14,843 (15,004) tons, shorts, 14,819 (17,651) tons and middlings 5,160 (4,596) tons.

Cereal production for June 1938 was higher than for the same month a year ago. Production was as follows with figures for June last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 628,374 (401,239); Rolled Oats, 7,220,012 (7,382,593); Corn Flour and Meal, 3,753,470 (1,902,675); Pot and Pearl Barley, 152,292 (90,752); and Buckwheat Flour, 100,106 (58,258).

Animal feed products were firm with a generous increase in mixed grain over the same month last year. These compared as follows: Ground Oats, 6,300,653 (6,198,669) pounds; Cracked Corn, 8,905,375 (7,947,795) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,228,092 (3,281,410) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 38,261,695 (27,542,243) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of June, 1938 amounted to 894,297 barrels compared with 1,032,056 barrels for the same month last year and 907,110 barrels for the previous month.






