CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

January, 1939.

Ottawa, Canada, March 2, 1939.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for January, 1939, with comparison for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for January, 1939 amounted to 94,096 barrals.

SUMMARY

During the month of January, 1939, 4,976,225 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,137,413 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Coarse grains were higher than for January, 1938.

Orains ground for the month of January, 1939 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 4,976,225 (4,137,413); Oats 1,164,676 (1,088,788); Corn 255,181 (222,147); Barley 128,494 (108,179); Buckwheat 14,015 (15,413); and Mixed Grain 2,248,195 (1,578,220).

Mill stocks of wheat on January 31, 1939 emounted to 4,500,835 bushels, while for the same month in 1938 the amount was 4,662,271 bushels.

Flour production in January, 1939 amounted to 1,097,822 barrels compared with 921,285 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in January, 1939 amounted to 379,538 barrels compared with 295,776 barrels in January 1938.

Flour production amounting to 1,097,822 barrels for the month of January 1939 was the highest recorded for this month since 1931. Percentage of operation for January was 50.1 as against 38.7 for the corresponding month last year. Wheat offal increased over January 1938 with bran 17,626 (13,319) tons, shorts 17,400 (13,774) tons and middlings 5,444 (4,042) tons.

Cereal production for January, 1939 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in breckets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 1,961,424 (830,502); Rolled Cats, 11,875,262 (11,770,834); Corn Flour and Meal, 2,945,808 (2,214,502); Pot and Pearl Barley, 238,712 (168,400); and Buckwheat, 226,790 (218,730).

Millfeeds were higher throughout the group than for the corresponding month a year ago. The items compared as follows: Ground Oats; 10,315,645 [8,486,492] pounds; Cracked Corn, 7,702,374 (7,143,921) pounds; Ground Barley, 5,637,781 (4,797,008) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 100,374,286 (70,732,094) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of January, 1939 amounted to 794,199 barrels compared with 1,175,014 for the same month in 1938 and 1,147,926 barrels for the previous month.


