CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

March, 1939.

Ottawa, Canada, May 4, 1939.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for March, 1939, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month end wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for March, 1939 amounted to 94,04% barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of March, 1939, 5,411,833 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,498,940 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Oats, buckwheat and mixed grain were higher than for March, 1938, while corn and barley were lower.

Grains ground for the month of March, 1939 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 5,411,833 (4.498,940); Oats 1,112,025 (945,541); Corn 252,736 (279,0.8); Barley 114,985 (115,917); Buckwheat 8,074 (6,951); and Mixed Grain 2,119,586 (1,610,123).

Mill stocks of wheat on March 31, 1939 amounted to 4,740,755 bushels, while for the same month in 1938 the amount was 3.590.551 bushels.

Flour production in March, 1939 amounted to 1,193,717 barrels compared with 999,387 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in March, 1939 amounted to 300,752 barrels compared with 301,735 barrels in March, 1938.

In the face of uncertainty in regard to political developments in Europe, Canadian flour millers have enjoyed better business in the month of March, 1939. Production of flour amounted to 1,193,717 barrels compared with 999,387 barrels for the corresponding month of last year or an increase of 194,330 barrels. March production has not been so large since the crop year 1929-30, when 1,220,671 barrels were manufactured in that month. Total flour production for the eight months of the present crop year ending March, 1939 amounted to 10,635,217 barrels compared with 9,200,010 barrels for the same period last year.

The plentiful supply of wheat in Canada combined with the fact that the millers are able to buy at favourable prices has placed Canadian flour in a position to compete with a fair margin of profit in world markets. Flour exports from Canada in March, 1939 amounted to 360,752 barrels compared with 301,735 barrels in March, 1938. Total shipments for the eight months of the present crop year were 3,008,528 barrels as against 2,545,339 barrels for this period a year ago.

Millfeeds for March, 1939 followed the upward trend of flour with bran 19,445 (14,983) tons, shorts 17,472 (14,555) tons, and middlings 7,182 (4,619) tons.

Cereal production for March, 1939 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal 601,190 (579,750); Rolled Oats, 11,855,986 (9,995,402); Corn Flour and Meal 2,624,648 (2,208,412); Pot and Pearl Barley, 351,514 (346,802); Buckwheat Flour, 131,016 (112,447).

Animal feed products compared as follows: Ground Oats, 11,705,420 (9,341,035) pounds; Cracked Corn, 8,013,042 (8,427,732) pounds; Ground Barley, 4,587,913 (4,769,187) pounds; and Mixed Grain 94,617,692 (71,780,349) pounds.

Total flour stocks for March, 1939 amounted to 1,233,619 barrels compared with 1,082,707 barrels for the same month last year and 1,074,143 barrels for the previous month.


