## CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS July, 1940

Ottawa, Canada, September 5, 1940.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for July, 1940 with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for July, 1940 amounted to 90,935 barrels.

#### SUMMARU

During the month of July, 1940, 5,543,957 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 5,171,901 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, cats, barley and mixed grain were higher than for July, 1939, while corn and buckwheat were lower.

Grains ground for the month of July, 1940 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Theat 5,543,957 (5,171,901); Oats 892,812 (855,723); Corn 184,259 (231,752); Burley 196,828 (96,139); Buckwheat 1,724 (3,523); and Mixed Grain 1,613,715 (1,161,520).

Mill stocks of wheat on July 31, 1940 amounted to 4,407,105 bushels, while for the same month in 1939 the amount was 4,383,005 bushels.

Flour production in July, 1940 amounted to 1,222,975 barrels compared with 1,105,502 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in July, 1940 amounted to 313,864 barrels compared with 403,377 barrels in July, 1939.

Flour production for July 1940 amounted to 1,222,975 barrels compared with 1,105,502 barrels for the same month in 1939. The crop year closed with a total manufacture of 17,749,764 barrels as against 15,234,065 barrels in the same period in 1938-39. The percentage of output to capacity for July, 1940 was 53.9 compared with 51.7 in July 1939, while the weighted average for the twelve months was 65.7 compared with 56.6 a year ago.

Exports of flour for July, 1940 amounted to 313,864 barrels compared with 403,377 barrels in the same month last year. Exports for the present crop year reached a total of 6,781,367 barrels in comparison with 4,604,245 barrels for the same period last year.

Millfeeds for the final month of 1939-40 were steady with bran 17,045 (14,776) tons, shorts 18,260 (18,617) tons and middlings 11,115 (12,258) tons.

Cereal production for July, 1940 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 217,708 (512,732); Rolled Oats, 9,981,664 (9,609,067); Corn Flour and Meal, 2,327,108 (2,095,892); Pot and Pearl Barley, 124,105 (96,030); and Buckwheat Flour, 27,584 (56,368).

Production of animal feed was as follows: Ground Oats, 9,386,900 (7,833,616) pounds; Cracked Corn, 4,075,632 (6,033,609) pounds; Ground Barley, 9,225,152 (4,396,767) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 71,598,938 (51,872,428) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of July, 1940 amounted to 1,079,734 barrels compared with 987,385 barrels for the same month last year and 1,081,682 barrels for the previous month.


