January, 1942

Catawa, Canada, March 5, 1941. The Dominica Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for James P. 1942, with comparison for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour experts.

The daily constity reporting for January, 1941 amounted to 89,229 barrels.

HMMARY

During the month of Jessery 1942, 7,000,600 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 5,896,870 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, cats, corn and barley were higher than for January, 1941, while buckwheat and mixed grain were lower.

Grains ground for the month of January 1942 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets. Wheat 7,020,607 (5,293,370); Oats 1,445,283 (722,400); Corn 218,409 (216,418); Barley 280,864 (195,316); Buckwheat 4,555 (8,716); and Mixed Grain 2,622,854 (2,719,911).

Mill stocks of wheet on January 31, 1942 amounted to 7,240,574 bushels, while for the same month in 1941 the amount was 6,050,723 bushels.

Flour production in January 1942 amounted to 1,555,850 barrels compared with 1,177,369 barrels for the same month last year. Expense of flour in January, 1943 amounted to 250,363 barrels compared with 354,818 barrels in January, 1941.

Flour production for the month of January, 1942 amounted to 1,555,850 barrels compared with 1,177,369 barrels for the same month in 1941. January production has not been so high sincs 1928-29. Production for the first six months of the crop year amounted to 9,893,802 barrels compared with 8,641,743 barrels in the same period of 1940-41. The percentage of operation for the month under survey was 71.3 compared with 51.5 in January, 1941. Wheat offal production was higher for the month with bran 21,869 (18,555) tons, shorts 20,206 (16,320) tons and middlings 12,071 (6,157) tons.

Cereal production for January, 1942 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 258,796 (191,366); Rolled Oats, 16,824,689 (5,327,690); Corn Flour and Meal, 1,750,280 (2,143,302); Pot and Pearl Barley, 419,293 (263,622); and Buckwhest Flour, 74,072 (139,456).

Coarse grain feeds were steady with Ground Oats 16,511,026 (13,759,206) pounds, Cracked Corn 6,489,404 (6,726,962) pounds; Ground Barley 12,509,688 (8,760,735) pounds, and Mixed Grain 117,864,536 (122,135,082) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of January, 1942 amounted to 1,193,022 barrels compared with 1,016,919 barrels for the same month last year and 1,175,267 barrels for the previous month.


