CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

October, 1942

Ottawa, Canada, December 3, 1942.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for October, 1942, with comparisons for the previous year and inventory for the month.

The daily capacity reporting for October, 1942 amounted to 89,292 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of October, 1942, 8,233,257 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 7,141,859 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, barley, buckwheat and mixed grain were higher than for October, 1941, while cats and corn were lower.

Grains ground for the month of October, 1942 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 8,233,257 (7,141,859); Oats 1,372,205 (2,248,609); Corn 203,566 (281,759); Barley 474,567 (237,061); Buckwheat 26,405 (17,283); and Mixed Grain 2,772,999 (2,510,689).

Mill stocks of wheat on October 31, 1942 amounted to 6,512,883 bushels, while for the same month in 1941 the amount was 6,107,510 bushels.

Flour production in October, 1942 amounted to 1,851,062 barrels compared with 1,595,931 barrels for the same month last year.

Flour production in October, 1942 amounted to 1,851,062 barrels compared with 1,695,931 barrels for the same month last year, the highest production for the present crop year. The total production for the three months of 1942-43 amounted to 5,408,733 barrels against 5,095,980 barrels. The percentage of output to capacity was 80.6 compared with 69.9 for October, 1941.

Willfeeds for the menth increased over last year with bran 24,918 (22,449) tons, shorts 23,497 (22,222) tons and middlings 13,119 (10,662) tons.

Cereal production for October, 1942 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmesl, 1,728,287 (411,492); Rolled Oats, 10,608,865 (29,364,622); Corn Flour and Heal, 2,140,418 (1,946,868); Pot and Fearl Earley, 602,386 (574,329); and Buckwheat Flour, 459,872 (500,654).

Animal feed products for October, 1942 showed an increase over last year in all items except cracked corn. The amounts were as follows: Ground Oats, 23,132,216 (17,816,226) pounds; Cracked Corn, 4,910,708 (7,325,248) pounds; Ground Earley, 21,423,435 (10,046,032) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 126,342,749 (112,216,626) pounds.

Total flour stocks for October, 1942 amounted to 912,757 barrels compared with 1,081,576 barrels for the same month last year and 964,759 barrels for the previous month.
