CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

February, 1942

Ottawa, Canada, April 2, 1942.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for February, 1942, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and the accumulative total of wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for February, 1942 amounted to 91,781 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of February, 1942, 7,081,029 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 6,557,760 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, cats and barley were higher than for February, 1941, while corn, buckwheat and mixed grain were lower.

Grains ground for the month of February, 1942 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 7,081,029 (6,557,760); Oats 879,502 (851,108); Corn 182,264 (215,963); Barley 239,120 (210,572); Buckwheat 900 (3,466); and Mixed Grain 2,172,896 (2,723,724).

Mill stocks of wheat on February 28, 1942 amounted to 7,997,364 bushels, while for the same month in 1941 the amount was 5,724,709 bushels.

Flour production in February, 1942 amounted to 1,584,978 barrels compared with 1,452,187 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in February, 1942 amounted to 1,056,348 barrels compared with 506,757 barrels in February, 1941.

Canadian mills reported a flour production of 1,584,978 berrels in the month of February, 1942 compared with 1,462,187 barrels in the same month last year. Total production for the seven months covered in this crop year amounted to 11,478,780 barrels compared with 10,103,930 barrels in the same period, 1940-41. The percentage of operation for the month under review was 73.5 against 68.2 in February last year. Millfeeds, in comparison with the same month last year, were bran 22,422 (22,967) tons, shorts 20,354 (19,084) tons and middlings 10,252 (8,286) tons.

Cereal production for February, 1942 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 244,957 (204,513); Rolled Oats, 7,896,298 (6,556,102); Corn Flour and Keal 1,170,686 (1,488,528); Pot and Fearl Barley, 581,432 (352,778); and Buckwheat Flour, 14,872 (61,088).

In the animal feed group, ground barley was the only item showing an increase over the amounts of February, 1941. The four items compared as follows: Ground Oats, 14,437,394 (14,918,140) pounds; Cracked Corn, 5,206,195 (6,843,225) pounds; Ground Barley, 10,124,159 (9,865,210) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 97,800,669 (121,908,468) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of February, 1942 amounted to 1,108,963 barrels compared with 820,787 barrels for the same month lest year and 1,193,022 barrels for the previous month.




