Ottawa, Canada, Merch 4, 1943 .- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for January, 1943, with comparisons for the previous year and inventory for the months

The daily capacity reporting for January, 1943 amounted to 90,450 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of January 1943, 8,771,769 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 7,020,607 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the course grain group, corp. barley and mixed grains were higher than for January 1942, while cats and buckwheat were lower.

Grains ground for the month of January 1943 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: "Thest 8,771,769 (7,020,607); Oats 1,300,070 (1,445,283); Corn 238,946 (219,409); Barley 46P,934 (280,864); Buckwheat 3,628 (4,555); and Mixed Grain 3,226,128 (2,622,854).

Mill stocks of wheat on Jenuary 31, 1943 amounted to 8,799,961 bushels, while for the same month in 1942 the amount was 7,240,574 bushels.

Flour production in January 1943 amounted to 1,963,042 barrels compared with 1,555,850 barrels for the same month last year.

Canadian flour mills manufactured 1,963,042 barrels of flour for the month of January, 1943 compared with 1,555,850 barrels for the same month last year. This was the highest January production on record. Total production for the six months ending January, 1943, amounted to 11,408,011 barrels compared with 9,893,802 barrels for the same period a year ego. The percentage of output to capacity for January, 1943 amounted to 89,0 compared with 71.3 for the same month last year.

Millfeeds for January, 1943 followed the trend of flour and edvanced over the same month last year with bran 26,515 (21,869) tons, shorts 25,257 (20,206) tons and middlings 13,926 (12,071) tons.

Cereal production for January, 1943 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Ostmaal 269,994 (258,796); Rolled Oats 7,054,595 (16,824,689); Corn Flour and Meal 2,038,268 (1,750,280); Pot and Pearl Barley 303,395 (419,293); and Buckwhsat Flour 59,512 (74,072).

Animal feed products increased over January, 1942 in all items except corn. These were as follows: Ground Oats 29,641,971 (16,511,025) pounds; Gracked Corn 6,165,096 (6,489,404) pounds; Ground Barley 22,560,394 (12,509,688) pounds; and Mixed Grain 147,737,489 (117,864,536) pounds.

Total flour stocks for January, 1943 amounted to 937,364 barrels compared with 1,193,022 barrels for the same month last year and 867,109 barrels for the previous month.


