CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

OCTOBER, 1943

Ottawa, December 2, 1943.- Froduction of wheat flour in Canadian mills for the month of October amounted to 2,118,409 berrels, the highest monthly production so far this crop year. The comparative figure for October, 1942 was 1,851,062 barrels. Total production of wheat flour for the first quarter of the crop year 1943-44 was 6,020,694 barrels compared with 5,408,733 barrels for the same period last year.

Mills reporting October operations had a total milling capacity of 87,289 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 93.3 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in September operated 91.5 per cent of their combined reted capacity.

The quantity of wheat ground during October was 9,349,024 bushels, compared with 8,233,257 bushels in the same month last year. In the coarse grains, cats and barley were ground in larger quantities than in October, 1942, but corn, buckwheat and mixed grain decreased in volume.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of October, 1945 amounted to 5,344,506 bushels compared with 6,016,895 bushels at the end of September.

The production of Ontario winter wheat flour dropped to 30,539 barrels in October compared with 105,048 barrels for the same month last year. This was the lowest monthly production since May 1935, when 29,923 barrels were produced.

Millfeeds produced in October amounted to 69,812 tons compared with 61,534 tons in October, 1942. This was comprised of bran 28,308 (24,918) tons, shorts 27,973 (23,497) tons, and middlings 13,531 (13,119) tons.

The total of the four items representing "Ground Feeds" amounted to 197,436,467 pounds for October compared with 175,809,106 pounds for the same month a year ago. The items were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats, 39,745,833 (23,132,216); Cracked Corn, 4,493,205 (4,910,708); Ground Barley, 42,075,502 (21,423,433); and Mixed Grain. 111,121,927 (126,342,749).
