CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

JUNE 1943

Ottawa, August 5, 1945.- Production of wheat flour in Canadian mills fell off sharply during June. The output in barrels of 196 pounds each amounted to 1,855,461 barrels, the smallest production in any month since October 1942, according to preliminary figures compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

Mills reporting June operations had a combined milling capacity of 90,572 barrels per 24-hour day, but over a 26-day working period during the month only 80.2 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in May operated 91.6 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

The quantity of wheat ground during June was 8,255,007 bushels compared with 5,988,535 bushels in June 1942. In the other grains, all except Buckwheat were ground in larger volume than in June a year ago.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of June 1943 amounted to 6,398,808 bushels, an increase of 561,614 bushels over the stocks on hand at the end of May.

Production of Bran, Shorts and Middlings during June showed a drop of 5,509 tons compared with May and reflected the smaller grindings of wheat into flour. The production during the eleven months ending June 1943 totalled 723,182 tons which compares with 675,550 tons produced in the twelve months ending July 31, 1942.

It will be noted from the above table covering "Ground Feeds" that June operations were substantially greater than in June a year ago, especially in the case of oats, barley and mixed grain. This is an indication of the greatly expanded market for live stock feed.

Exports of wheat flour up to the end of April show a total of 9,007,115 barrels for the first nine months of the crop year 1942-43. This is a substantial increase over the previous year when the August-April exports totalled 7,889,480 barrels.
