CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

September, 1943

Ottawa, November 4, 1943.- Production of wheat flour in Canadian mills for the month of September amounted to 2,014,255 barrels, an increase of 126,225 barrels over the previous month's production. The comparative figure for September, 1942 was 1,737,472 barrels.

Mills reporting September operations had a total milling capacity of 88,030 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 25-day working period in the month 91.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

The quantity of wheat ground during September was 8,946,009 bushels, compered with 7,804,651 bushels in the same month last year. In the other grains, cats, corn and barley were ground in larger volume then in September a year ago, but huck-wheat and mixed grain dropped in volume.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of September, 1943 amounted to 6,016,895 bushels compared with 6,792,559 bushels at the end of August.

The effect of the short crop of Ontario winter wheat is reflected in the winter wheat flour production in September, which the above table shows to be less than half the output for the same month in 1942.

The quantity of millfeed produced in September, 1943 was 67,043 tons, compared with 59,302 tons in the same month last year. This was comprised of 27,529 tons of bren as against 22,757 in September, 1942, shorts 26,347 tons compared with 22,281 and middlings 13,167 tons as against 14,264.

"Ground Feeds" in September increased in the aggregate over the same month last year, but with variations in the items. The amounts in detail were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats, 35,573,980 (21,082,971); Cracked Corn, 3,756,518 (5,300,524); Ground Barley, 33,965,913 (19,759,338); and Mixed Grain, 105,949,852 (116,326,614).
