# CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

### JANUARY 1944

Ottawa, March 2, 1944.- Production of wheat flour in Canadian mills for the month of January amounted to 2,041,193 barrels compared with 1,963,042 barrels for the same month last year. Total flour produced for the first half of the current crop year amounted to 12,411,151 barrels, an increase of slightly more than a million barrels over the same period of 1942-43 when the amount was 11,408,011 barrels.

Mills reporting January operations had a total milling capacity of 87,822 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 25-day working period in the month 93.0 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in December operated 94.8 per cent of their combined capacity.

The quantity of wheat ground during January was 8,987,626 bushels bringing the helf-year total for 1943-44 to 54,814,407 bushels compared with 50,957,920 bushels for the same period of the previous crop year. The coarse grain grind for January increased in oats, barley and buckwheat but fell off in corn and mixed grain.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of January 1944 amounted to 6,094,405 bushels, compared with 6,130,144 bushels at the end of December.

Production of Ontario Winter wheat flour for January amounted to 22,674 barrels compared with 87,866 barrels for the same month last year.

Exports of wheat flour for January were 1,125,034 barrels, the highest monthly quantity for the current crop year, making a total of 5,934,575 barrels exported for the first half of 1943-44.

Millfeed production for January was 65,994 tons compared with 65,698 tons for the corresponding month last year. This was comprised of bran 27,656 (26,515) tons, shorts 25,373 (25,257) tons and middlings 12,965 (13,926) tons.

"Ground Feeds" for January compared as follows with the same menth last year: Ground Oats, 33,219,345 (29,641,971) pounds; Cracked Corn, 4,168,652 (6,165,096) pounds; Ground Barley, 42,205,159 (22,560,394) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 123,641,095 (147,737,489) pounds.
