CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

DECEMBER 1944

Ottawa, February 1, 1945.- Froduction of wheat flour in Canadian mills for the month of December emounted to 2,029,530 barrels compared with 2,173,433 barrels for the same month last year. Flour production for the year ending December 1944 totalled 24,292,051 barrels, a drop of 182,645 barrels from the previous year's total of 24,471,000 barrels.

Mills reporting December operations had a total milling capacity of 89,661 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 25-day working period in the month of 90.5 per cent of this was affective. Mills reporting in November operated 98.1 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

The quantity of wheat milled in December was 9,030,913 bushels compared with 9,583,573 bushels in the same month a year ago. Wheat milled for the year ending December 1944 amounted to 107,303,854 bushels compared with 108,448,431 bushels for the previous calendar year. Coarse grains declined in volume for the month in all grains except cats.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of December 1944 amounted to 6,891,752 bushels compared with 7,568,027 bushels at the end of November.

The December production of Ontario Winter wheat flour was 93,053 barrels compared with 28,628 barrels in December 1943.

Exports of wheat flour for December amounted to 1,242,370 barrels bringing the calendar year total to 13,938,243 barrels, an all-time high in Canadian exports of flour for any single year. Total exports of flour for the five months of this crop year, August to December, amounted to 5,283,413 barrels. This was more than half the production for the same five months.

Millfeed production in December was 67,933 tons compared with 70,272 tons for the same month last year. This was made up of bran 27,171 (27,927) tons, shorts 25,826 (28,518) tons and middlings 14,936 (13,827) tons.

"Ground Feeds" for December compared as follows with the same month last year: Ground Oats, 34,635,912 (34,352,142); Cracked Corn, 4,187,892 (4,240,073) pounds; Ground Barley, 35,874,781 (44,119,537) pounds; and Fixed Grain, 122,264,756 (134,473,842) pounds.
