CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

FEBRUARY, 1944

Ottawa, April 6, 1944.- Production of wheat flour in Canadian mills for the month of February amounted to 2,087,705 barrels compared with 1,990,732 barrels for the same month last year. This brought the total for the seven months covered in the crop year to 14,498,656 barrels against 13,398,743 barrels in the first seven months of 1942-43.

Mills reporting February operations had a total milling capacity of 87,966 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 25-day working period in the month 94.9 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in January operated 93.0 per cent of their combined capacity.

The quantity of wheet ground during February was 9,194,576 bushels compared with 8,864,552 bushels in the same month a year ago. The cumulative total for the seven months under report amounted to 64,008,983 bushels compared with 59,822,472 bushels for the same period in the previous crop year. In the coarse grains, cats, barley and buckwheat were higher for the month than in February 1943.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of February 1944 amounted to 6,156,314 bushels, compared with 6,094,405 bushels at the end of January.

Production of Onterio Winter wheat flour for February was the lowest this crop year, amounting to 16,640 berrels compared with 77,488 berrels for the same month last year. Total production for the seven months of the crop year 1943-44 amounted to only 240,039 barrels, the lowest total production for the first seven months of any crop year since 1921-22 when the quantity milled was 226,970 barrels in the period.

Exports of wheat flour for February were 854,272 barrels, making a total for the seven months of 6,788,847 barrels.

Millfeed production for February was 67,747 tons compered with 66,646 tons for the same month in 1943. The items making the totals were bran 28,142 (27,702) tons, shorts 26,458 (25,105) tons and middlings 13,147 (13,639) tons.

"Ground Feeds" for February compared as follows with the same month last year: Ground Oats, 33,501,120 (26,866,492) pounds; Cracked Corn, 4,060,790 (6,160,794) pounds; Ground Barley, 36,029,304 (18,678,359) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 120,606,955 (135,466,784) pounds.
