### CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

## MAY, 1944

ottawa, July 6, 1944.- Production of wheat flour in Canadian mills for the month of May rose slightly over the previous month, but fell below the better then two million average production for the past ten months. The output amounted to 1,962,264 barrels compared with 2,099,996 barrels for the month of May last year. Total production for the ten months covered this crop year amounted to 20,676,964 barrels against 19,749,123 barrels in the same period of 1942-45.

Mills reporting May operations had a total milling capacity of 87,463 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period 86.3 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in April operated 92.3 per cent of their combined capacity.

The quantity of wheat ground in May was 8,619,952 bushels compared with 9,276,153 bushels for the same month last year, bringing the total for the ten months to 91,090,072 bushels compared with 87,916,004 bushels for the same period last crop year. In the coarse grain group, cats, barley and buckwheat were higher than for May, 1943, while corn and mixed grain were lower.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of May, 1944 amounted to 5,292,070 bushels compared with 5,338,269 bushels at the close of April.

The production of Ontario Winter wheat flour for May was 17,376 barrels compared with 84,940 barrels for the same month last year.

Exports of wheat flour for May amounted to 1,575,589 barrels, the highest monthly figure for this crop year.

Millfeed production for May was 63,846 tons compared with 67,694 tons for the same month in 1943, comprising bran 25,926 (28,759) tons, shorts 25,244 (26,307) tons and middlings 12,676 (12,628) tons.

"Ground Feeds" for May compared as follows with the same month last year: Ground Oats, 48,568,695 (31,928,556) pounds; Cracked Corn, 4,424,605 (6,494,124) pounds; Ground Berley, 33,197,414 (20,119,526) pounds; and Mired Grain, 90,016,208 (109,334,554) pounds.
