GANADIAN WILLING STATISTICS

JANUARY 1945

Ottawa, March 1, 1945.- Canadian production of wheat flour in January amounted to 2,068,232 barrels compared with 2,041,193 barrels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Flour production for the first half of the present crop year ending with January totalled 12,441,364 barrels, slightly higher than the six months' total for the preceding year which was 12,41,151 barrels.

Mills reporting January operations had a total milling capacity of 88,125 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 90.3 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in December operated 90.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

The quantity of wheat milled in January was 9,177,050 bushels compared with 8,987,626 bushels in the same month a year ago. Wheat milled for the six months under survey for this crop year amounted to 55,235,944 bushels compared with 54,814,407 bushels for the same six months in 1943-44. In the coarse grain group, oats, corn and buckwheat were higher than for the same month a year ago but barley and mixed grain were lower.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of January, 1945 amounted to 6,596,325 bushels compared with 6,891,752 bushels at the end of December.

Production of Ontario winter wheat flour in January amounted to 86,112 barrels against 22,674 barrels in the same month last year. Total output for the first six months of this crop year was 537,088 barrels, while in the corresponding period of the previous year the amount was only 223,399 barrels.

Exports of wheat flour for January were 840,479 barrels, bringing the six months' total for the crop year 1944-45 to 6,123,892 barrels. The total for the corresponding six months of 1943-44 amounted to 5,934,575 barrels.

Millfeed production in January amounted to 68,088 tons compared with 65,994 tons in the same month a year ago. This was comprised of bran 27,317 (27,656) tons, shorts 26,592 (25,373) tons and middlings 13,579 (12,965) tons.

"Ground Feeds" for January were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats 36,930,486 (33,219,345); Cracked Corn 5,829,074 (4,168,652); Ground Barley 34,895,006 (42,205,159); and Mixed Grain 115,311,854 (123,641,095).




