CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS DECEMBER 1945

Ottawa, January 31, 1946:- Production of wheat flour in Canadian mills for the month of December amounted to 2,168,751 barrels compared with 2,029,550 barrels for the same month last year. The year 1945 was a banner year in the history of wheat flour production with a total output of 25,059,218 barrels against 24,292,051 barrels for the year 1944.

Mills reporting December operations had a total milling capacity of 89,982 barrels per 24-h ur day and over a 25-day working period in the month 96.4 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in November operated 97.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

The quantity of wheat milled in December was 9,657,932 bushels compared with 9,030,913 bushels in the same month a year ago. Wheat milled for the year ending December 1945 amounted to 111,277,878 bushels compared with 107,303,814 bushels for the previous calendar year. In the coarse grain group for December, there was a decline in the volume of cats, barley and buckwheat reported in comparison with the same month last year but an increase in corn and mixed grain.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of December 1945 amounted to 7,650,903 bushels while at the end of November the amount was 8,624,621 bushels.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for December 1945 amounted to 87,833 barrels compared with 93,053 barrels for the same month a year ago. Total production for the five months of this crop year was 488,324 barrels compared with 450,976 barrels for the same period in 1944-45.

Total millfeeds for December amounted to 72,425 tons compared with 67,933 tons in December 1944. This was comprised of bran 30,729 (27,171) tons, shorts 29,329 (25,826) tons and middlings 12,367 (14,936) tons.

Wheet flour exports for December were 965,433 barrels, bringing the calendar year total to 13,730,584 barrels compared with 13,938,631 barrels exported in the calendar year 1944.

"Ground Feeds" for December were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats 37,658,183 (34,635,912); Gracked Corn 3,906,820 (4,187,892); Ground Barley 32,906,827 (35,874,781); and Mixed Grain 127,604,514 (12~,264,756).
