CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

JULY 1945

Ottawa, September 6, 1945. Wheat flour production in Canadian mills for the month of July amounted to 1,822,193 barrels compared with 1,741,564 barrels for the same month in 1944. Despite the fact that July had the lowest monthly production parrols compared with 1,7e1,500 barrels for the same month in 1944. Despite the fact that July had the lowest monthly production throughout this crop year, total output for the year ending with July amounted to 24,664,403 barrels compared with 24,286,877 barrels in the crop year 1943-44. Production rose steelily during the past six war years from a total of 17,778,311 berrels in 1959-40 to the present total of 24,664,403 barrels, and although 1944-45 did not reach the estimated production of 25-million barrels, yet it exceeded all previous years on record.

Mills reporting July operations had a total milling especity of 88,703 barrels per 84-hour day, but over a 85-day working period during the month only 82.2 per cent of this was effective. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year was 91.2 per cent compared with 90.0 per cent for 1943-44.

The quantity of wheat milled in July was 8,093,417 bushels compared with 7,710,266 bushels in the same month lest year. The total wheat milled for the drop year ending with July was 109,464,388 bushels against 107,071,741 bushels for the corresponding period of the previous erop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of July ascumted to 6,299,717 bushels compared with 6,411,973 bushels on hand at the end of June.

Ontario winter wheat flour manufactured in July amounted to 55,694 barrels compared with 42,547 barrels in the same month last year. Total production for the present crop year amounted to 1,035,914 barrels, while for 1943-44 the total reached a low of 361,198 barrels.

July exports of wheat flour amounted to 1,148,464 barrels, bringing the year's total to 13,923 832 barrels, the highest crop year export in the history of milling in Canada.

Millfeed production for July was lower than any single production during the crop year. The output amounted to only 60,638 tons of bran, shorts and middlings. Nevertheless, the grand total of 815,672 tons for the year ending with July topped all former years.

"Ground Feeds" for July were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats 33,521,031 (26,393,787); Cracked Corn 4,144,970 (2,305,535) Ground Barley 19,607,342 (23,471,669); and Mixed Grain 78,996,745 (68,422,423).






WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
