#### CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

### AUGUST 1945

Ottawa, October 4, 1945. Wheat flour production for the month of August amounted to 2,020,867 barrels compared with 2,015,866 barrels for the same month last year. This was the highest August production figure on record.

Mills reporting August operations had a total milling capacity of 88,565 barrels per 24-hour day, but over a 26-day working period in the month 87.8 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in the previous month (July) operated 82.2 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

The total quantity of wheat milled into flour during August was 8,969,829 bushels compared with 8,936,210 bushels in the same month last year. This total included 450,623 bushels of Ontario winter wheat against 392,947 bushels. In the coarse grains, barley showed a lower trend for the mouth in comparison with August 1944.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of August 1945 amounted to 7,333,310 bushels, while at the end of July the stocks amounted to 6,298,717 bushels.

Production of Ontario winter wheat flour in the opening month of the new crop year was the highest August figure since 1940-41 and amounted to 109,049 barrels against 76,331 barrels in the same months in 1944-45.

Total exports of wheat flour for August amounted to 1,106,467 barrels compared with 753,462 barrels for the same month last year. Other high August export figures occurred in 1943-44 with 1,121,568 barrels, 1941-42 with 1,436,566 barrels, 1919-20 with 1,171,222 barrels and 1917-18 with 1,050,037 barrels.

Millfeed production for August was higher than for the same month in 1944 with 68,104 tons against 66,596 tons, with the breakdown showing bran 28,310 (26,916) tons, shorts 27,138 (26,250) tons and middlings 12,656 (13,430) tons.

Crushed feeds were higher than for the comparative month last year in all items except Ground Barley. The amounts were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats 36,809,943 (30,040,952); Cracked Corn 4,217,620 (2,356,904); Ground Barley 21,125,155 (26,265,317); and Mixed Grain 97,389,026 (96,719,155).




