CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

SEPTEMBER 1945

Ottawa, November 1, 1945.- Wheat flour production as reported by Canadian mills for September amounted to 2,045,850 barrels, an increase of 24,965 barrels over the opening month of this crop year. The quantity milled for September a year ago was 1,972,621 barrels. The total quantity of flour milled for the first two months of this crop year amounted to 4,066,697 barrels, an increase of 78,210 barrels over the same two months in 1944-45.

Mills reporting September operations had a total milling capacity of 88,434 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 24-day working period in the month 96.4 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in August operated 87.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity over a 26-day period.

The total quantity of wheat milled during September was 9,104,988 bushels compared with 8,728,340 bushels in the same month last year. Ontario winter wheat included in these quantities amounted to 470,540 hushels and 368,862 bushels respectively. Total wheat milled to the end of September was 18,074,817 bushels compared with 17,864,550 bushels for the same two months a year ago.

The coarse grain group showed a decline in the amount of barley milled and ground so fer this crop year as compared with last. The amount was 960,347 bushels against 1,341,548 bushels for the first two months of 1944-45.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of September, 1945 amounted to 7,950,251 hushels compared with 7,355,510 bushels on hand at the end of August.

Ontario winter wheat flour milled for September 1945 amounted to 100,753 barrels compared with 66,833 barrels for the same month a year ago.

Wheat flour exports for September amounted to 954,215 barrels and, though down from the previous month, the total exports for the first two months of this crop year amounted to 2,060,682 barrels compared with 1,969,145 barrels in the same period of 1944-45.

Millfeed production for September increased over the same month a year ago with some variation in the breakdown which showed bran 29,454 (26,018) tons, shorts 26,318 (25,988) tons and middlings 12,631 (13,047) tons.

Ground feeds for the month of September compared with the same month last year were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats, 35,714,449 (32,626,969); Cracked Corn, 3,510,582 (1,290,523); Ground Barley 22,371,112 (31,361,313); Mixed Grain, 99,816,459 (98,549,273).


