

CAMADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

JANUARY 1946

Ottawa, March 7, 1946.- Canadian mills reported a wheat flour production of 2,240,242 barrels in the month of January against 2,068,232 barrels for the same month a year ago. Flour production for the first half of the present crop year ending with January totalled 12,989,189 barrels, an increase of more than 500,000 barrels over the six months' total for the preceding crop year when the production was 12,441,364 barrels.

Mills reporting January operations had a total milling capacity of 90,163 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 95.6 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in December operated 96.4 procent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour in January amounted to 9,964,985 bushels compared with 9,177,050 bushels in the same month in 1945. Total wheat milled for the six months under review for this crop year was 57,837,369 bushels compared with 55,235,944 bushels for the same six months in 1944-45. Coarse grains milled and ground for January were slightly lower in most items as compared with the same month a year ago, but showed a marked drop in buckwheat and rye.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of January, 1946 amounted to 8,491,901 bushels compared with 7,650,903 bushels at the end of December.

Onterio winter wheat flour production in January amounted to 86,916 barrels compared with 86,112 barrels in the same month last year. Total output for the first six months of this crop year was 577,140 barrels while for the corresponding period of the previous crop year the amount was 537,088 barrels. This more normal production of winter wheat flour was in sharp contrast to the low production of 223,346 barrels in the first six months of 1943-44.

Exports of wheat flour for January were 1,138,797 barrels, the highest single export for any month during this crop year. Total exports for the first half of this crop year amounted to 6,229,350 barrels as compared with 6,124,081 barrels for a like period in 1944-45.

Millfeed production for the month under survey was 74,088 tons compared with 68,088 tons for the corresponding month a year ago. The breakdown was bren 30,008 (27,917) tons, shorts 30,359 (26,592) tons and middlings 11,721 (13,579) tons. Total millfeed production to the end of January this crop year amounted to 435,047 tons against 413,321 tons in the first six months of 1944-45.

"Ground Feeds" for January were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats 39,855,040 (36,930,486); Cracked Corn 4,092,888 (5,829,074); Ground Barley 33,464,205 (34,895,006); and Eixed Grain 117,650,576 (115,311,854).




