# CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

### OCTOBER 1946

Ottawa, November 28, 1946. - Flour production in Canadian mills for the month of October amounted to 2,432,875 barrels compared with 2,227,182 barrels for the same month a year ago. This was the largest single monthly production on record and the first time in milling history that output reached and surpessed the 2.4 million barrel mark. Flour produced in the first quarter of the present crop year was 6,819,250 barrels against 6,293,879 barrels in the same period last year.

Mills reporting October operations had a total milling capacity of 92,270 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 101.4 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in September operated 100.6 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheat used in the production of flour for the month of October amounted to 10,846,694 bushels compared with 9,925,524 bushels for the same month in 1945. Onterio winter wheat included in the month's grind amounted to 287,963 bushels compared with 442,040 bushels in the same month last year. Wheat used for flour in the first quarter of the present crop year was 30,349,851 bushels as compared with 28,000,341 bushels for the same period in 1944-45.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of October 1946 amounted to 5,494,271 bushels, while at the end of September the carry-over was 5,5%5,064 bushels.

Onterio winter wheat flour production for October 1946 was 67,513 barrels compared with 97,994 barrels for the same month last year. This was the lowest monthly production of winter wheat flour for the present crop year. The quarterly output was 246,636 barrels compared with 307,796 barrels for the first quarter of 1944-45.

Wheat flour exports for October amounted to 985,726 barrels, making a total of 4,198,859 barrels exported for the first quarter of this crop year compared with 3,124,919 barrels for a like period a year ago.

Fillfeed production for October followed the upward trend of flour and the output of 83,587 tons for the month was the highest single production on record. Millfeeds for the same month last year amounted to 75,059 tons. The breakdown was bran 37,334 (32,399) tons, shorts 33,100 (29,017) tons and millings 13,133 (13,843) tons.

Ground feed items for the month of October were as Pollous with comparisons for last year and the quantities in pounds: Weed Theat 14,506,768 (no comparable figure); Ground Oats 41,369,370 (41,492,026); Gracked Corn 4,524,520 (1,692,131); Ground Barley 41,967,843 (33,574,775); and Mixed Grain 97,730,952 (118,975,053).









# WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
