CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

NOVEMBER 1946

Ottawn, January 1947.- Flour production in Canadian mills for the month of November amounted to 2,518,555 barrels compared with 2,285,317 barrels for the same month a year ago, and for the month under review production passed the 2 1/2 million mark for the first time in milling records. Heavy domestic demands coupled with export commitments gave the mills a busy month. Flour production for the four months ending with November amounted to 9,337,805 barrels against 8,579,196 barrels for the same period in 1945-46.

Mills reporting November operations had a total milling capacity of 93,235 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 26-day working period in the month 103.9 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting for October operated 101.4 per cent of their combined reted capacity.

Wheat milled into flour for November amounted to 11,239,067 bushels compared with 10,214,111 bushels in the same month last year. Total wheat used for the four months ending with November amounted to 41,588,918 bushels compared with 38,214,452 bushels for the same period in the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of November 1946 amounted to 7,295,022 bushels, while at the end of October the stocks were 5,494,271 bushels.

TOTAL OFFAL

Ontario winter wheat flour production for November 1946 amounted to 64,913 barrels as corpared with 92,695 barrels for the same month last year. Total production for the four months ending with November amounted to 311,549 barrels while for the same period in 1945-46 the production was 400,491 barrels.

Wheat flour exports for the month under report amounted to 1,368,060 barrels hringing the four months' total for this crop year to 5,566,919 barrels against 4,125,120 barrels for the same four months in 1945-46.

November millfeed production was the highest on record amounting to 85,708 tons compared with 76,708 tons for the same month a year ago. The breakdown for millfeeds was bran 37,876 (32,955) tons, shorts 34,260 (30,344) tons and middings 13,572 (13,469) tons. Total millfeed production to the end of November this crop year was 318,991 tons compared with 288,534 tons for a like period in 1945-46.

There was a heavy grind of course grain feeds during the month under review with feed wheat shown separately from mixed grain. The comparisons with last November were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 17,937,535 (no comparable figure): Ground Gats 48,403,507 (38,640,162); Cracked Corn 4,639,929 (1,624,946); Ground Barley 46,356,889 (34,801,476); and Mixed Grain 109,107,708 (126,274,219).




