CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

DECEMBER 1946

Ottawa, January 30, 1947.- Canadian flour mill production for the month of December was 2,350,040 barrels as compared with 2,168,751 barrels in the same month last year. Production for five months of the current crop year ending with December amounted to 11,687,845 barrels, an advance over the same period a year ago when the production amounted to 10,747,947 barrels. The annual output of flour has increased steadily since 1938 until in the calendar year 1946 the all-time high production of 27,375,239 barrels almost doubled the production of 13,752,011 barrels in 1938.

Mills reporting December operations had a total milling capacity of 92,885 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 25-day working period in the month 101.2 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in November operated 103.9 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Theat milled for flour in December amounted to 10,498,514 bushels compared with 9,657,932 bushels in the same month last year. This brought the total wheat milled for five months of the current crop year to 52,087,432 bushels compared with 47,872,384 bushels for the same period in the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of December 1946 amounted to 7,154,606 bushels, while at the end of November the amount was 7,295,022 bushels.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for December 1946 amounted to 64,679 barrels as compared with 87,633 barrels for the same month last year. Total production for the first five months of the current crop year ending with December amounted to 376,228 barrels against 488,324 barrels for the same period in 1945-46.

Wheat flour exports for December were down from the previous month to 721,744 barrels, but the total so fer this crop year was 6,288,563 barrels, exceeding the same period in 1945-46 when the total amounted to 5,090,553 barrels.

Millfeed production for December amounted to 80,577 tons compared with 72,425 tons for the same month a year ago, with bren 35,393 (30,729) tons, aborts 32,808 (29,329) tons and middlings 12,376 (12,376) tons. Total millfeed production for the first five months of the current crop year amounted to 399,565 tons compared with 360,959 tons for the same period of the previous crop year.

Coerse grain feeds and feed wheat grind continued heavy for December. The items were as follows with comparable figures for December 1945 in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 17,714,462 (no comparable figure); Ground Oats 45,606,624 (37,658,183); Gracked Corn 4,300,367 (3,906,820); Ground Barley 39,830,691 (32,906,827); and Mixed Grain 106,872,629 (127,604,514).









WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
