

CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

MAY 1946

Ottawa, July 4, 1946.- Canadian flour mill operations for the month of May continued at a high level and the month's output was only 48,100 barrals short of the top production for March. Production for May amounted to 2,343,827 barrals compared with 2,107,944 barrals for the same month last year. The cumulative total for ten months of the current crop year was 22,087,548 barrals compared with 20,728,684 barrals for the same period in 1944-45.

Mills reporting May operations had a total milling capacity of 89,688 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 100.5 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in April operated at 98.6 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheat manufactured into flour in the month of May amounted to 10,400,404 bushels against 9,318,762 bushels in the same month last year. Total wheat milled for the ten months ending with May amounted to 98,257,692 bushels compared with 91,935,522 bushels for the same ten months of the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the close of May 1946 amounted to 5,849,071 bushels while for the same month in 1945 the stocks were 7,213,070 bushels.

The quantity of Outario winter wheat flour produced in May was 86,365 barrels compared with 73,724 barrels for the same month a year ago. For the ten months of 1945-46 ending with May the output of Ontario winter wheat flour amounted to 942,771 barrels compared with 905,490 barrels for a like period in 1944-45.

Oatmeal and rolled cats production for ten months of the current crop year totalled 182,317,837 pounds compared with 187,211,973 pounds for the same ten months of 1944-45.

The quantity of flour exported from Canada in May was 1,668,125 barrels, the highest single export for any month so far this crop year and the highest single export since July 1941 when 1,921,665 barrels were exported. Total exports for ten months of this crop year amounted to 11,553,563 barrels as against 11,162,769 barrels for the corresponding period of the previous crop year.

Millfeed production for May was 78,154 tone compared with 68,276 tone for the same month last year. The break down for millfeeds was bran 33,762 (28,830) tone, shorts 31,871 (27,481) tone and middlings 12,521 (11,965) tone.

Ground feeds for the month of May were higher than for the same month a year in all items except mixed grain. Compariso were as follows with the quantities in pounds: Ground Oats 43,343,914 (34,141,421); Cracked Corn 3,710,761 (3,142,331); Ground Barley 36,719,126 (27,657,103); and Mixed Grain 93,898,370 (95,143,531).




