CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

JULY 1946

Ottawa, September 5, 1946.- Canadian flour mills reported a wheat flour production of 2,164,145 barrels for the month of July compared with 1,822,193 barrels for the same month last year. Production of flour remained above the 2-million mark for each month of the present crop year, ranging from the lowest monthly output of 2,020,867 barrels in August to the highest monthly output of 2,392,927 barrels in March. Total production of flour for this crop year was the highest on record, amounting to 26,435,341 barrels against 24,684,403 barrels for 1944-45, an increase of 1,750,938 barrels in the yearly output.

Mills reporting July operations had a total milling capacity of 91,366 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 91.1 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in June operated at 97.2 per cent of their combined rated capacity. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year was 96.5 per cent compared with 91.2 per cent for 1944-45.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for July amounted to 9,625,556 hushels compared with 8,093,417 bushels for the same month last year. Total wheat milled for the crop year ending with July was 117,609,336 bushels compared with 109,464,388 bushels for the crop year 1944-45. Wheat milled for the present crop year included 4,654,458 bushels of Ontario winter wheat against 4,857,818 bushels in last year's total.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the close of July 1946 amounted to 5,208,021 bushels while for the previous month the stocks were 4,904,713 bushels.

Ontario winter wheat flour manufactured in July amounted to 63,358 barrels compared with 55,694 barrels in the same month last year, bringing the total for the current crop year to 1,077,758 barrels compared with 1,035,914 barrels for the crop year 1944-45. Production for the year ending with July was the second largest in the past twenty-five year record, exceeded only in 1942-43 when the amount was 1,083,045 barrels.

Exports of wheat flour for July amounted to 1,172,289 barrels. The total year's export amounted to 13,786,177 barrels, a drop of 137,655 barrels from the 1944-45 total of 13,923,832 barrels.

Millfeed production for July amounted to 72,164 tons compared with 60,638 tons for the same month a year ago. This was comprised of bran 31,891 (25,538) tons, shorts 28,616 (24,001) tons and middlings 11,657 (11,099) tons. The current crop year total for millfeeds amounted to 881,844 tons, a record output for any single year under review.

Ground feeds for the month of July were as follows with the quantities in pounds and last year's figures in brackets: Ground Oats 33,289,265 (33,521,031); Cracked Corn 3,996,903 (4,144,970); Ground Barley 31,192,757 (19,607,342); and Mixed Grain 77,589,757 (78,996,745).





WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION






