

CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS DECEMBER 1947

Ottawn, January 29, 1948 - Flour production as raported by Canadian mills for the month of December dropped to 1,691,610 barrels, a decrease of 567,673 barrels from the previous month, representing the lowest December output of flour since December 1941 and the lowest monthly output for any single month since July 1942. The comparative December production of flour for 1946 was 2,350,040 barrels. Production for the first five months of the current crop year was 11,275,780 barrels against 11,687,845 barrels for the same period a year ago.

Mills reporting December operations had a total milling capacity of 98,865 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 65.8 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting for November operated 85.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour in December amounted to 7,552,165 bushels compared with 10,498,514 bushels for the same month in 1946. Total wheat used for flour in the five months of the current crop year ending with December amounted to 51,030,545 bushels as compared with 52,087,432 bushels for the same five months of the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of December 1947 amounted to 8,311,658 bushels, while at the end of Movember the amount was 6,664,400 bushels.

The production of Ontario winter wheat flour for December 1947 was 61,602 barrels compared with 64,679 barrels for the same month a year ago. This brought the total production for the five months under review this crop year to 340,167 barrels against 376,228 barrels for the same five months of 1946-47.

Wheat flour exports for December 1947 amounted to 1,091,555 barrels. Total exports for the first five months of the current crop year ending with December totalled 5,710,436 barrels compared with a total of 6,288,663 barrels exported for the same period a year ago.

Millfeed production for December dropped to a low of 59,951 tons compared with 80,577 tons for the same month of the previous year. The breakdown was bran 25,132 (35,393) tons, shorts 24,537 (31,808) tons and middlings 10,282 (12,376) tons. Total millfeed production for the five months under review to the end of December 1947 amounted to 398,466 tons, while for the same period of the previous year the amount was 399,568 tons.

Total ground feeds for the month of December amounted to 174,092,731 pounds against 212,324,773 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 15,195,447 (17,714,462); Ground Oats 38,608,259 (43,606,624); Gracked Corn 797,984 (4,300,367); Ground Barley 32,459,422 (39,830,691); and Mixed Grain 87,031,619 (106,872,629).






WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
