

CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

MARCH 1947

Ottawa, April 24, 1947.— Canadian mills reporting for the month of March showed a flour production of 2,354,128 barrels compared with 2,392,927 barrels for the same month last year. The total flour output for the eight months covered to the end of March of this crop year amounted to 18,732,045 barrels, an increase over the comparative total of 17,526,791 barrels for the same period in 1945-46. Should this steady rate of production be maintained to the close of the present crop year, a possible annual total of 28,000,000 barrels would be reached.

Mills reporting March operations had a total milling capacity of 90,565 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 26-day working period in the month 99.9 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in February operated 99.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

The amount of wheat used in the manufacture of flour for March was 10,490,910 bushels, while for the same month in 1946 the amount was 10,661,527 bushels. Total wheat milled for the current crop year to the end of March was 83,575,474 bushels compared with 78,017,817 hushels for the same period in 1945-46.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the close of March 1947 were 5,756,257 bushels while at the end of February the amount was 6,021,237 bushels.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for March 1947 amounted to 59,888 barrels compared with 90,808 barrels for the same month of the previous year. The total output of Ontario winter wheat flour for the eight months covered to the end of March of this crop year amounted to 552,933 barrels, while for the same period in 1945-46 the amount was 761,002 barrels.

Exports of wheat flour for March amounted to 1,356,020 barrels, bringing the total export for the eight months under survey to 16,254,594 barrels as compared with 2,400,697 barrels for the same period a year ago.

Milifeed production for March 1947 was 79,671 tons compared with 79,318 tons for the corresponding month last year. This was comprised of bran 34,299 (34,241) tons, shorts 32,311 (31,491) tons, and middlings 13,061 (13,586) tons. Total milifeed production for the first eight months of the current crop year amounted to 636,656 tons, an increase over last year's comparative production of 585,483 tons

Ground feeds for March 1947 were as follows with the quantities in journis and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed Wheat 16,862,272 (no comparable figure); Ground Cats 49,218,519 (42,820,121); Gracked Corn 6,448,037 (5,102,406); Ground Barley 23,505,718 (31,431,983); and Mixed Grain 100,902,372 (107,595,450).




