CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS JUNE 1947

Ottawa, July 31, 1947.- Production of wheat flour in Canada for mills reporting for the month of June amounted to 2,497,324 barrels compared with 2,183,648 barrels for the same month last year, an increase of 313,676 barrels. Total production for eleven months of the current crop year ending with June was 26,253,619 barrels, an increase over the comparative total of 24,271,196 barrels for the same period in 1945-46.

Mills reporting June operations had a total milling capacity of 92,130 barrels per 24-hour and over a 25-day working period in the month 108.4 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in June operated 108.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for June amounted to 11,188,146 bushels, while for the same month in 1946 the amount was 9,726,088 bushels. Total wheat processed into flour for eleven months of the current crop year ending with June amounted to 117,295,941 bushels as compared with 107,983,780 bushels for the corresponding period in 1945-46.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the close of June 1947 amounted to 5,674,981 bushels, while at the end of May the amount was 6,068,526 bushels.

Ontario winter wheet flour milled for June 1947 amounted to 61,535 barrels against 71,629 barrels for the same month a year ago. The total output of Ontario winter wheat flour for the eleven months covered to the end of June of this crop year amounted to 738,374 barrels as compared with 1,014,400 barrels for a like period in 1945-46.

Exports of wheat flour for the month under report amounted to 2,341,605 barrels, bringing the eleven months' total for this crop year to 16,018,788 barrels in comparison with 12,613,888 barrels for the same period last year. NOTE: The export figure published in the June 26 release of Monthly Milling Statistics for the ten months total for the crop year 1945-46 should be revised to read 11,553,563 barrels.

Total millfeeds for June amounted to 84,783 tons compared with 73,248 tons for the corresponding month a year ago. The breakdown was bran 36,840 (31,310) tons, shorts 35,166 (29,502) tons, and middlings 12,777 (12,436) tons.

Ground feeds for June 1947 were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed Wheat 20,570,009 (no comparable figure); Ground Oats 58,567,623 (35,979,925); Cracked Corn 4,919,040 (2,937,543); Ground Barley 32,548,754 (32,110,367); and Mixed Grain 69,575,071 (69,445,445).


