CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS SEPTEMBER 1947

Ottawa, October 50, 1947: According to returns from Canadian mills, wheat flour production for the month of September amounted to 2,481,189 barrels, an increase of 68,795 barrels over the opening month of the current crop year. The comparative figure for September 1946 was 2,227,748 barrels. The total quantity of flour milled for the first two months of this crop year amounted to 4,893,585 barrels compared with 4,386,375 barrels for the same two months in 1946-47.

Mills reporting September operations had a total milling capacity of 96,215 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 25-day working period in the month 105.2 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in August operated 96.2 per cent of their combined rated capacity over a 26-day period.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for September was 11,199,740 bushels compared with 9,938,159 bushels for the same month a year ago.

Ontario winter wheat included in the total for the month was 247,788 bushels against 545,449 bushels for September 1946. Wheat milled for the first
two months of the current crop year amounted to 22,150,270 bushels, while for the same two months last crop year 19,503,157 bushels were used.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of September 1947 amounted to 6,046,606 bushels as compared with 6,250,621 bushels in mills at the end of August.

Ontario winter wheat flour milled for the month of September 1947 amounted to 55,515 barrels, a decrease of 14,921 barrels from the opening month of the current crop year. Ontario winter wheat flour for September of last year was 81,882 barrels. The total amount manufactured for the first two months of this crop year was 125,947 barrels compared with 179,125 barrels for the same period in 1946-47.

Wheat flour exports for September amounted to 1,292,628 barrels, bringing the total for the first two months of 1947-48 to 2,838,412 barrels compared with 3,213,153 barrels for the same two months a year ago.

Millfeed production for the month under review amounted to 87,393 tons compared with 77,376 tons for September 1946. The breakdown was bran 38,397 (53,239) tons, shorts 34,751 (30,799) tons and middlings 14,245 (13,338) tons.

Total ground feeds for the month of September amounted to 177,645,147 pounds compared with 173,226,085 pounds for the same month a year ago. The items in this group were as follows with comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 18,942,617 (10,749,981); Ground Oats, 51,666,722 (37,434,423); Cracked Corn, 4,454,464 (4,145,994); Ground Berley 55,478,510 (36,766,824); and Mixed Grain, 67,122,834 (84,128,861).





WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION MILLION






