CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS JANUARY 1948

Ottawn, February 26, 1948. The sharp decline in flour production occurring in the month of December was halted temporarily and Canadian mills operating the same number of days in January produced 1,889,350 barrels of wheat flour, or an increase of 197,740 barrels over the December output. However, total production for the first half of the current crop year ending with January dropped slightly more than one million barrels, amounting to only 13,165,130 barrels as compared with 14,165,710 barrels for the first half of 1946-47.

Mills reporting January operations had a total milling capacity of 98,310 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 73.9 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting for December operated 65.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for January amounted to 8,621,746 bushels, while for the same month a year ago the amount was 11,077,206 bushels. Total wheat milled for the six months under review to the end of January 1948 was 59,652,291 bushels compared with 63,164,638 bushels for the same period in the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of January 1948 amounted to 7,418,845 bushels, while at the close of December the stocks amounted to 8,311,658 bushels.

Ontario winter wheat flour projection for January 1948 amounted to 62,467 barrels compared with 61,171 barrels for the same month last year, bringing the total for the first helf of the current crop year to 402,634 barrels against 437,399 barrels for a like-period in 1946-47.

Exports of wheat flour for January amounted to 991,226 barrels, the lowest monthly export for the current crop year. Nevertheless, total exports for the six months ending with January amounted to 7,701,662 barrels, recording a small increase over 7,668,339 barrels exported in the same period a year ago.

Millfeed production for the month under review was 67,774 tons, compared with 83,543 tons for January of last year. This was comprised of bren 27,737 (36,862) tons, shorts 27,791 (34,135) tons and middlings 12,246 (12,546) tons. Millfeed production for six months of the present crop year was 466,240 tons compared with 483,111 tons for the same period in 1946-47.

Total ground feeds for January amounted to 179,554,485 pounds as against 198,347,705 pounds for the same month lest year. Items included in this total were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 18,546,701 (19,426,585); Ground Oats 39,927,746 (44,671,316); Cracked Corn 4,781,685 (3,826,176); Ground Barley 37,107,614 (31,306,367); and Mixed Grain 79,190,739 (99,117,262).


