

CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS OCTOBER 1948

Ottawa, November 25, 1948 - Flour production in Canadian mills for the month of October declined from the previous month. The amount milled was 1,959,206 barrels against 2,489,087 barrels for the same month a year ago. The total output of wheat flour for the first quarter of the current crep year was 5,753,375 barrels compared with 7,376,497 barrels for the same period in 1947-48. This amounted to a reduction of 4623,122 barrels in the three months under review.

Mills reporting October operations had a total milling capacity of 102,015 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 25-day working period in the month 76.8 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in September operated 87.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

wheat milled for flour for the month of October amounted to 8,807,711 bushels as compared with 11,240,468 bushels milled in the same month last year. Ontario winter wheat included in the total for the month was 635,903 bushels against 358,638 bushels for October 1947. Wheat used for flour for the first quarter of 1948-49 amounted to 25,973,170 bushels while for the same period last year the amount was 33,360,397 bushels. Wheat milled for flour for the month of October amounted to 8,807,711 bushels as compared with 11,240,468 bushels milled in the

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of October 1948 amounted to 2,620,483 bushels for flour and 147,897 bushels of feed wheat.

The production of Ontario winter wheat flour reported for October amounted to 145,759 barrels as compared with 78,498 barrels for the same month last year. The total production of Ontario winter wheat flour for the first quarter of the present crop year amounted to 626,692 barrels. This amount more than trebled the same three-month period in 1947-48 when 204,984 barrels were milled.

Exports of wheat flour for October 1948 amounted to 1,300,286 barrels. This was the highest single monthly export so far this crop year and brought the total exported to the end of October to 3,046,102 barrels.

Millfeeds for October followed the lower trend in flour with an output of 69,131 tons against 87,383 tons for the same month last year. The breakdown was bren 26,234 (38,171) tons, shorts 26,924 (34,157) tons and middlings 15,973 (15,085) tons. The total production of millfeeds for the three months ending with October amounted to 201,626 tons as compared with 260,909 tons in the same three months of 1947-48.

Ground feeds for October totalled 169,429,074 pounds against 198,624,431 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this group were as follows with comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds. Feed Wheat 9,854,274 (21,189,570); Ground Oats 37,819,279 (52,047,189); Cracked Corn 3,216,564 (3,918,860); Ground Barley 36,109,865 (42,558,171); and Mixed Grain 82,429,092 (78,910,641).




