CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

NOVEMBER 1948

Ottawa, December 30, 1948 - Wheat flour production in Canadian mills for the month of Movember amounted to 1,936,427 barrels compared with 2,184,857 barrels for the same month last year. Production for the first four months of the current crop year was 7,689,802 barrels, while for the same period in 1947-48 the amount was 9,561,354 barrels.

Mills reporting November operations had a total milling capacity of 98,215 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 26-day working period in the month 75.8 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting for October operated 76.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheat milled into flour for November was 8,616,578 bushels against 9,912,545 bushels in same month a year ago. Total wheat used for flour in the four months ending with November amounted to 34,589,748 bushels compared with 43,272,942 bushels for the same period in 1947-48.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of November 1948 amounted to 5,117,515 bushels for flour and 134,279 bushels of

food wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for the month of November 1948 was 104,290 barrels compared with 75,140 barrels for the same month last year. This brought the total for the four months ending with November to 730,982 barrels, while for a like period in 1947-48 the amount was 278,124 barrels.

Wheat flour exports for the month under review amounted to 1,108,598 barrels, bringing the total exported for four months of this crop year to 4,164,627 barrels against 5,713,227 barrels for the same four months a year ago.

Millfeed production for November amounted to 67,023 tons compared with 77,432 tons for the same month in 1947. This was comprised of bran 25,714 (32,976) tons, shorts 25,489 (31,191) tons and middlings 15,820 (13,265) tons. Total millfeed production for the first four months of the current crop year was 268,649 tons, while for the same period in 1947-48 the total was 338,341 tons.

Ground feeds for November totalled 192,837,143 pounds against 197,155,388 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this group were as follows with comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 10,388,075 (20,384,294); Ground Oats 43,332,137 (48,511,576); Cracked Corn 3,849,488 (2,190,697); Ground Barley 42,450,891 (39,749,688); and Mixed Grain 92,816,552 (86,319,132)




