> > CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

FEERUARY 1948

Ottawa, March 25, 1948 - Wheat flour output from Canadian mills for the month of February amounted to 1,799,279 barrels as compared with 2,212,207 barrels for the same month in 1947. February had the second lowest monthly production during the current grop year, due in part to a shorter working period in the month. Total flour production in the first seven months of 1947-48 amounted to 14,964,409 barrels against 16,377,917 barrels for the same period in the previous crop year.

Mills reporting February operations had a total milling capacity of 99,040 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 24-day working period in the month 75.7 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in January operated 73.9 per cent of their combined rated capacity over a 26-day period.

wheat milled for flour in February amounted to 8,156,702 bushels against 9,917,926 bushels for the same month last year. Total wheat milled for seven months of the current crop year ending with February was 67,808,993 bushels. This was a decrease of 5,273,571 bushels from the total milled for the same peried of the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the end of February 1948 amounted to 7,408,574 bushels, while at the close of January the stocks amounted to 7,418,845 bushels.

Ontario winter wheat flour production in February, 1948 was 61,962 barrels, while for the same month a year ago the production was 55,646 barrels. Total production for the seven months of the current crop year ending with February amounted to 464,596 barrels as compared with 493,045 barrels for the same period in 1946-47.

February exports of wheat flour amounting to 769,667 barrels were the lowest monthly exports so far this crop year. This brought the total export from the commencement of the current crop year to the end of February to 8,471,329 barrels against 8,898,574 barrels for the corresponding period last year.

Millfeed production for February 1948 amounted to 63,310 tons, while for the same month last year the amount was 73,874 tons. This was comprised of bran 26,024 (31,834) tons, shorts 26,145 (30,320) tons, and middlings 11,141 (11,720) tons. Total millfeed production to the end of February of this crop year was 529,550 tons compared with 556,965 tons for a like period in 1946-47.

Ground feeds for the month under review were down in volume in all items except Ground Barley when compared with February a year ago. The items were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed Wheat 16,189,300 (17,464,074); Ground Oats 36,832,105 (44,976,216); Gracked Corn 3,173,864 (4,737,492); Ground Barley 36,296,677 (27,004,428); and Mixed Grain 68,542,261 (102,563,459).




