CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

MAY 1948

Ottawa, June 24, 1948 - Production of wheat flour in Canada for mills reporting for the month of May amounted to 1,726,281 barrels as compared with 2,610,806 barrels for the same month of the previous year. This was the second lowest monthly production during the current crop year, while the comparative May figure was the highest monthly production during the preceding crop year. Total production for ten months of the current crop year ending with May was 20,517,603 barrels compared with 23,688,642 barrels for the same period in 1946-47.

Mills reporting May operations had a total milling capacity of 96,540 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 25-day working period in the month 71.5 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in April operated 75.9 per cent of their combined rated capacity.

Wheet used in the production of flour for May amounted to 7,891,917 bushels, while for the same month in 1947 the amount was 11,678,441 bushels. Total wheat milled into flour for the ten months under review for the current crop year ending with May amounted to 93,121,513 bushels as compared with 106,683,976 bushels for the same period last crop year.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the close of May 1948 amounted to 5,001,406 bushels, while at the end of April the amount was 5,674,463 bushels.

The highest single month's production of Ontario winter wheat flour in the ten months under review this crop year occurred in May 1948 when the amount manufactured was 85,469 barrels as compared with 72,204 barrels in the same month a year ago. This brought the total of Ontario winter wheat flour to 691,93% barrels for the ten months ending with May while for a like period in 1946-47 the amount was 673,185 barrels.

Exports of wheat flour for May amounted to 1,714,985 barrels, marking a substantial increase in shipments over any previous month of this crop year and bringing the total exported for the first ten months of 1947-48 to 12,203,501 barrels as compared with 13,623,279 barrels for the same period a year ago.

Willfeeds for May followed the lower trend of flour production and amounted to 63,140 tons against 88,853 tons for the same month in 1947. The breakdown was bran 25,042 (39,120) tons, shorts 23,122 (35,567) tons and middlinge 14,976 (14,066) tons. Total production of millfeeds for ten months ending with May amounted to 731,031 tons against 811,553 tons for the same ten-month period of 1946-47.

The total ground feeds for May amounted to 147,104,342 pounds as compared with 205,394,651 pounds for the same month last year. The items making up these totals were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed Wheat 18,201,375 (18,464,577); Ground Oats 39,991,236 (62,067,652); Cracked Corn 3,100,148 (4,498,734); Ground Barley 33,010,626 (36,647,925); and Mixed Grain 52,800,957 (83,715,763).






WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION MILLION
