

### CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

#### JULY 1948

Ottawa, August 26, 1948 - Canadian wheat flour production in 1947-48 crop year isclined from the record output of 28,588,456 barrels established in 1946-47 to 24,243,711 barrels, the lowest crop year production since 1942-43. The monthly output for July 1948 was 1,814,297 barrels against 2,251,030 barrels for the same month a year ago.

Mills reporting July operations had a total milling capacity of 96,585 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 26-day working period in the month 72.3 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in June operated 81.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity. The weighted average of working capacity for the current crop year was 81.0 per cent compared with 100.8 per cent for 1946-47.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for July 1948 amounted to 8,336,785 bushels compared with 10,110,001 bushels used in July of lest year. The total wheat milled for flour for the current crop year ending with July amounted to 110,205,651 bushels compared with 127,775,176 bushels for 1946-47. Ontario winter wheat milled for the year and included in the total amounted to 3,322,919 bushels, while for 1946-47 the amount was 3,114,707 bushels.

Stocks of wheat in flour mills at the close of July 1948 amounted to 1,639,127 bushels for flour and 214,834 bushels of feed

wheat.

Winter wheat flour manufactured in July amounted to 61,767 barrels, while for the corresponding month last year the amount was 37,041 barrels. This brought the total winter wheat flour for the current crop year to 842,638 barrels against 772,588 barrels for the crop year 1946-47.

Exports of wheat flour for July declined to 661,161 barrels. This was the lowest export figure for any single month in the crop year under review. The total exports for the twelve months of 1947-48 amounted to 13,906,114 barrels.

Millfeed production for July was 67,965 tons as compared with 77,560 tons for the same month a year ago. This was comprised of bran 26,893 (33,742) tons, shorts 24,762 (31,057) tons and middlings 16,310 (12,761) tons. The current crop year's output of millfeeds totalled 868,866 tons against 972,535 tons for 1946-47.

Ground feeds for July totalled 142,599,121 pounds against 175,804,790 pounds for the same month last year. The breakdown showed a decrease in all items except feed wheat. The items were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures for last year in brackets: Feed Wheat 26,187,862 (21,283,651); Ground Oats 35,023,079 (52,066,687); Cracked Corn 2,768,922 (4,446,016); Ground Barley 32,403,644 (35,665,751); and Mixed Grain 46,215,614 (62,342,685).




