CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

JANUARY 1949

Ottawa, February 24, 1949 - Flour production declined sharply in the month of January with an output of 1,462,422 barrels against 1,900,739 barrels recorded for the same month last year. Total production covering the first half of the current crop year ending with January amounted to 10,886,123 barrels, a falling off in production of more than 2.2 million barrels when compared with 13,115,575 barrels produced in the same six months of 1947-48.

Mills reporting January operations had a total milling capacity of 97,810 barrels per 24-hour day and over a 25-day working period in the month 60.1 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting for December operated 67.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity over a period of 26 days.

Wheat processed in the flour for January amounted to 6,523,962 bushels, while for the same month a year ago the amount was 8,672,649 bushels. Total wheat a field for the six months under review to the end of January was 48,808,841 hushels compared with 59,426,774 bushels for the same period of the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat it 11 bins at the close of January 1949 amounted to 2,870,723 bushels for flour and 180,930 bushels of feed wheat.

The production of winter wheat flour for January 1949 amounted to 79,923 barrels compared with 62,277 barrels for the same month last year, bringing the total for the first half of the current crop year to 893,581 barrels. This was more than double the output of 402,465 barrels reported for the same period in 1947-48.

Exports of wheat flour for January amounted to 1,003,893 barrels. Total exports for the six months covered to the end of January amounted to 5,345,451 barrels compared with 7,467,354 barrels for a like period in 1947-48.

The downward trend in flour production for January was reflected in millfeeds with a production of 49,614 tons compared with 68,145 tons for the same month a year ago. The breakdown was bran 19,988 (27,869) tons, shorts 18,888 (28,066) tons and middlings 10,728 (12,210) tons. Millfeed production for the first six months of the current crop year was 376,611 tons against 465,167 tons for the same six months a year ago.

Total ground feeds for January amounted to 169,346,948 pounds against 172,764,595 pounds for the same month last year. The items in the group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 8,459,096 (17,846,661); Ground Oats 36,601,912 (39,269,750); Cracked Corn 7,227,335 (3,305,465); Ground Barley 37,117,529 (35,861,174); and Mixed Orain 79,941,076 (76,481,525).
