CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production as reported by Canadian mills for the month of November amounted to 1,950,539 barrels against 1,965,302 barrels for the same month in 1948. This year's November output was the highest single month's production so far this crop year. Total production for the first four months of the current crop year was 7,416,467 barrels, while for the same period in 1948-49 the amount was 7,719,574 barrels.

Mills reporting November operations had a total milling capacity of 98,690 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 26-day working period in the month 76.0 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in October had the same percentage for 25 days.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for November 1949 was 8,690,627 bushels compared with 8,751,968 bushels in the same month a year ago. Total wheat milled for flour in the four months ending with November amounted to 33,075,328 bushels compared with 34,719,104 bushels for the same period in 1948-49.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of November 1949 amounted to 3,811,090 bushels for flour and 123,579 bushels of feed wheat.

November production of winter wheat flour amounted to 98,758 barrels compared with 107,840 barrels for the same month last year. This brought the total for the four months ending with November 1949 to 418,771 barrels, while for a like period in 1948-49 the amount was 736.919 barrels.

Wheat flour exports for November amounted to 822,131 barrels against 1,212,229 barrels for the corresponding month a year ago. Total wheat flour exports for the four months ending with November amounted to 3,300,034 barrels compared with 4,417,501 barrels for the same four months of the crop year 1948-49.

Millfeed production for November amounted to 66,182 tons compared with 68,025 tons for the same month in 1948. The breekdown was bran 25,992 (26,152) tons, shorts 25,731 (25,878) tons and middlings 14,459 (15,995) tons. Total millfeed production for the first four months of the current crop year was 254,387 tons, while for the same period in 1948-49 the total was 269,613 tons.

Ground feeds for November totalled 181,433,969 pounds against 189,293,870 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this group were as follows with comparative figures in breckets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 11,047,866 (10,296,875); Ground Cate 47,745,887 (42,172,400); Cracked Corn 12,736,370 (4,055,344); Ground Barley 23,104,758 (41,515,559); and Mixed Grain 86,799,088 (91,153,692).




