#### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production reported by Canadian mills for the month of November 1950 amounted to 2,104,476 barrels compared with 1,945,697 barrels for the same month last year. This continued high production of flour brought the total for the first four months of the current crop year to 7,785,710 barrels, while for the same period in 1949-50 the total was 7,377,664 barrels.

Wheat flour mills operated 83.9 per cent of a reporting capacity of 96,459 barrels in November, based on a 26-day working period. Mills reporting in October operated 87.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in November amounted to 9,412,817 bushels compared with 8,669,735 bushels for the corresponding month a year ago. Total wheat used for flour in the four months ending with November amounted to 34,681,173 bushels against 32,896,012 bushels for the same period in 1949-50.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of November 1950 amounted to 3,391,565 bushels for flour and 136,474 bushels of

November production of winter wheat flour amounted to 97,079 barrels against 99,040 barrels for the same month last year. Winter wheat flour milled for the first four months of the present crop year ending with November 1950 totalled 431,316 barrels compared with 416,501 barrels for a like period in 1949-50.

Wheat flour exports for November 1950 rose above the previous months of the current crop year, with 1,051,655 barrels moving to other countries against 979,988 barrels for the same month last year. Total exports for the first four months of 1950-51 amounted to 2,998,485 barrels compared with 3,404,199 barrels for the same period of the previous crop year.

Millfeed production for November amounted to 73,647 tons compared with 66,003 tons for the same month in 1949. This was comprised of bran 30,302 (25,903) tons, shorts 31,838 (25,670) tons and middlings 11,507 (14,430) tons. Total millfeed production for the first four months of the current crop year was 270,817 tons, while for the same period in 1949-50 the total was 253,009 tons.

Ground feeds for November totalled 177,411,408 pounds compared with 179,645,108 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this group were as follows with comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,262,660 (10,980,766); Ground Oats 44,152,239 (47,351,861); Gracked Corn 6,539,547 (12,881,746); Ground Barley 19,276,863 (22,933,542); and Mixed Grain 93,180,099 (85,497,193).






