### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Price: \$1.00 a year.

Wheat flour production for mills in Canada for the month of March showed a firmer tone with an output of 1,850,721 barrels against 1,683,752 barrels for the same month in 1949. Production for the month under review was 15.2 per cent above that for February and brought the total for the eight months ending with March to 14,052,196 barrels, only slightly below the comparative output of 14,063,500 barrels for the same period in the previous crop year.

Mills reporting Merch operations had a total milling capacity of 97,640 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 27-day working period in the month 70.2 per cent of this was effective. Mills reporting in February operated 67.6 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 24 days.

Theat milled for flour for the month of Merch was 8,234,926 bushels, while for the same month a year ago the amount was 7,434,293 bushels. Total wheat processed into flour for the eight months covered to the end of March amounted to 62,542,495 bushels compared with 62,872,947 bushels for the corresponding period in 1948-49.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the end of March amounted to 1,711,327 bushels for flour and 88,867 bushels of feed wheat.

Winter wheat flour production for March amounted to 100,986 barrels compared with 67,156 barrels for the same month a year ago. Total production of this grade of flour for eight months of the present crop year ending with March was 847,726 barrels, while for the same period in 1948-49 the amount was 1,018,332 barrels.

Exports of wheat flour for March amounted to 805,085 barrels compared with 802,667 barrels for the same month last year, bringing the total exports for the eight months under review to 6,729.046 barrels against 7,585,007 barrels for the same period in 1948-49.

Millfeed production for March was 63,398 tons compared with 55,362 tons for the same month last year. The breakdown was bran 28,077 (26,544) tons, shorts 23,386 (20,764) tons and middlings 11,935 (7,754) tons. Millfeed output for the eight months of this crop year was 480,198 tons against 481,967 tons for the same eight months of the comparative crop year.

Ground feeds for the month of March totalled 155,606,412 pounds against 166,037,916 pounds for the same month in 1949. This was comprised of the following items with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 8,620,900 (8,302,199); Ground Oats 45,159,506 (38,421,957); Cracked Corn 11,053,583 (8,262,161); Ground Barley 23,728,732 (33,208,339); and Mixed Grain 67,043,691 (77.843,260).




