The 1949-50 wheat flour production season ended with the lowest July output reported since 1940. The amount recorded was 1,278,865 barrels compared with 1,480,319 barrels for July a year ago. However, the total production reported for the crop year just ended almost equalled that of 1948-49 with 20,303,871 barrels against 20,379,997 barrels.

Mills reporting July operations had a total milling capacity of 94,480 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 25-day working period in the month 54.1 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year just ended was 67.8 per cent compared with 67.3 per cent for 1948-49.

Wheat milled for flour for July 1950 amounted to 5,642,015 bushels, while for the corresponding month last year the amount was 6,595,584 bushels. This brought the total milled for the current crop year to 90,298,346 bushels compared with 90,896,984 bushels for the crop year 1948-49. Ontario winter wheat flour milled for this crop year and included in the above total amounted to 5,304,007 bushels against 5,665,656 bushels in 1948-49.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the end of July 1950 amounted to 1,705,340 bushels for flour and 68,585 bushels of feed wheat.

Winter wheat flour production for the month of July 1950 amounted to 65,535 barrels, while for the same month a year ago the amount was 66,157 barrels. Total winter wheat flour manufactured for the crop year ending with July 1950 was 1,154,967 barrels compared with 1,319,152 barrels for the previous crop year.

Exports of wheat flour for July 1950 amounted to 712,356 barrels, bringing the total exported for the crop year under survey to 10,042,968 barrels. Comparative exports for July last year amounted to 797,655 barrels with a crop year total of 10,687,561 barrels for 1948-49.

Milifeed output for July 1950, following the lower flour trend, amounted to 43,466 tons against 50,413 tons for the corresponding month last year. The breakdown was bran 16,438 (18,859) tons, shorts 19,102 (20,822) tons and middlings 7,926 (10,732) tons. Total milifeeds for the crop year 1949-50 came to 693,507 tons compared with 695,346 tons in the previous crop year.

Ground feeds for July 1950 totalled 116,888,037 pounds against 128,487,798 pounds for the same month a year ago. The items in this total were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures for July last year in brackets: Feed Wheat 13,839,700 (9,182,855); Ground Oats 31,400,663 (35,182,921); Gracked Corn 7,716,709 (9,024,262); Ground Barley 20,649,694 (28,403,798); and Mixed Grain 43,281,271 (46,693,962).




