GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Canadian flour mills reporting for the month of September 1950 had a wheat flour production of 1,859,762 barrels compared with 1,847,298 barrels for the same month last year. Wheat flour milled for the first two months of 1950-51 amounted to 3,573,622 barrels, slightly higher than the output of 3,560,869 barrels milled in the same two months of the previous crop year.

Mills reporting September operations had a total milling capacity of 95,810 barrels per 24-hour day, and over a 25-day working period in the month 77.6 per cent of this was effective. Kills reporting in August operated 66.7 per cent of their combined rated capacity over a 27-day period.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for September amounted to 8,268,585 bushels against 8,208,176 bushels for the same month a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the total for the month under review amounted to 636,732 bushels compared with 505,873 bushels for September 1949. Wheat milled for the first two months of the current crop year was 15,864,745 bushels, while for the same months in 1949-50 the amount was 15,867,812 bushels.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of September 1950 amounted to 2,594,114 bushels for flour and 139,823 bushels of

Ontario winter wheat flour production for the month of September 1950 amounted to 134,969 barrels compared with 104,748 barrels for the corresponding month last year. Total production of Ontario winter wheat flour for the first two months of the present crop year amounted to 222,773 barrels against 204,024 barrels for the same two months in 1949-50.

Wheat flour exports for September amounted to 508,648 barrels. This was the lowest September export since 1939-40, when 416,553 barrels moved to other countries. Total exports of flour for the two months covered so far this crop year amounted to 1,424,475 barrels, while for the same two months in 1949-50 the export was 1,704,251 barrels.

The output of millfeeds for September 1950 amounted to 64,155 tons compared with 63,691 tons for the same month a year ago. The breakdown was bran 24,185 (24,113) tons, shorts 26,177 (24,731) tons and middlings 13,793 (14,847) tons.

Groundfeeds for September amounted to 145,339,763 pounds, while for the same month in 1949 the amount was 165,989,116 pounds. The items included in this total were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds; Ground Wheat 13,131,420 (9,491,420); Ground Oats 35,548,141 (43,796,229); Gracked Corn 6,544,584 (10,276,652); Ground Barley 21,978,485 (29,319,788); and Mixed Grain 68,137,133 (73,105,027).


