GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Price \$1.00 a year.

The 1950-51 wheat flour season ended with the smallest monthly output of the crop year. Although the production was down from previous months, the recorded output of 1,405,086 barrels for July 1951 exceeded last year's comparative figure which amounted to 1,293,996 barrels. Total production reported for the crop year just ended amounted to 23,620,600 barrels against 20,259,200 barrels in 1949-50.

Mill operations for July averaged 57.4 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 97,954 barrels. Mills reporting in June operated 81.4 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year ended July 1951 was 79.8 per cent compared with 67.8 per cent for the previous crop year.

Wheat milled for flour for July 1951 amounted to 6,435,636 bushels, while for the corresponding month last year the amount was 5,702,548 bushels. This brought the total wheat milled for the present crop year to 106,703,533 bushels compared with 90,002,917 bushels for the crop year 1949-50. Ontario winter wheat milled for the year and included in the above total amounted to 4,846,584 bushels against 5,293,805 bushels for 1949-50.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the end of July 1951 amounted to 2,168,862 bushels for flour and 88,816 hushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for the month of July 1951 was 70,565 barrels compared with 65,641 barrels for the same month a y r ago. Total winter wheat flour manufactured for the crop year ending with July 1951 was lower than for the previous crop year with an ou rt of 1,057,280 barrels against 1,152,775 barrels.

July exports of wheat flour from Canada amounted to 1,190,220 barrels compared with 774,959 barrels last year, bringing the total exports for the crop year 1950-51 to 12,620,179 barrels, an increase of almost 2.5 million barrels above the previous crop year shipments of 10,151,090 barrels.

The lower trend for flour in July 1951 was again reflected in the millfeed production which dropped to 53,670 tons, the lowest monthly output for the crop year under survey. The comparative production for July a year ago was 43,893 tons. The breakdown was bran 20,195 (16,676) tons, shorts 22,335 (19,254) tons and middlings 11,140 (7,963) tons. Total millfeeds for the crop year ending with July 1951 amounted to 850,569 tons compared with 591,812 tons for the crop year 1949-50.

Ground feeds for July 1951 totalled 134,265,455 pounds compared with 108,298,906 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this total were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed Wheat 15,085,560 (12,315,380); Ground Oats 30,531,114 (28,561,463); Crscked Corn 9,371,984 (7,527,373); Ground Barley 21,474,273 (18,320,310); and Mixed Grain 57,800,504 (41,574,380).
