GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

For the second release for the 1951-52 crop season, wheat flour production for September as reported by Canadian mills amounted to 1,797,624 barrels compared with 1,863,053 barrels for the same month last year. Total wheat flour milled for the first two months of the current crop year amounted to 3,497,193 barrels, a reduction of 70,827 barrels from the same two months a year ago when the total was 3,568,020 barrels.

Mill operations for September averaged 76.1 per cent when computed on a 24-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 98,389 barrels. Mills reporting in August operated 64.4 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 27 days.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour for September amounted to 8,173,807 bushels against 8,282,280 bushels for the corresponding month last year. Ontario winter wheat included in the month under review amounted to 506,264 bushels gompared with 627,111 bushels for September 1950. Wheat milled for the first two months of the current crop year totalled 15,921,692 bushels, while for the same two months in 1950-51 the amount was 15,846,136 bushels.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of September 1951 amounted to 2,405,395 bushels for flour and 188,699 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for the month of September 1951 was 110,956 barrels compared with 132,954 barrels for the same month of the previous year. Total production of Ontario Winter wheat flour for the first two months of the present crop year amounted to 241,812 barrels against 222,453 barrels for the same two months in 1950-51.

Wheat flour exports amounting to 490,316 barrels for September 1951 fell below the previous month's shipments as well as from the shipments of the same month a year ago. The comparative shipment for September 1950 was 505,125 barrels. Total exports of flour for the August-September period of the current crop year amounted to 1,188,398 barrels against 1,185,135 barrels for the same period in 1950-51.

Millfeed output for September 1951 was 66,673 tons compared with 64,283 tons for September last year. The breakdown was bran 25,228 (24,236) tons, shorts 28,904 (26,252) tons and middlings 12,541 (13,797) tons.

Ground feeds for September amounted to 158,830,593 pounds, while for the same month in 1950 the amount was 153,993,571 pounds. The items included in this total were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 16,377,500 (15,306,420); Ground Oats 33,209,272 (37,753,103); Cracked Corn 8,951.080 (8,188,184); Ground Barley 24,621,852 (21,773,717); and Mixed Grain 75,660,889 (70,972,147).
