Wheat flour production for Canadian mills for the month of April 1952 proved a small morgin of increase over previous months of the current crop year. The reported April output amounted to 1,973,9% barrels compared with 2,087,839 barrels for the same month last year. Total production for the three-quarter period of the current crop year ending with April 1952 amounted to 16,679,858 barrels against 18,089,871 barrels for the same period in 1950-51.

Mills operating for April 1952 averaged 82.5 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 95,669 barrels. Mills reporting in March operated 77.3 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour in April 1952 amounted to 8,994,401 bushels, while for the same month last year the amount was 9,478,493 bushels. Total wheat used for flour in the three-quarter period under review for 1951-52 amounted to 76,460,003 bushels against 81,476,759 bushels for the same period in the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the end of April 1952 amounted to 2,286,482 bushels for flour and 232,007 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for April 1952 was 79,010 barrels compared with 71,299 barrels for this grade of flour in the same month last year. Total production of Ontario winter wheat flour for the August-April period of the current crop year was 809,387 barrels against 851,414 barrels for a like period in 1950-51.

Wheat flour exports for April were above the previous monthly shipments for this crop year with 1,190,008 barrels going to other countries compared with 1,290,904 barrels in April last year. Total flour exports for the August-April period in 1951-52 amounted to 7,604,035 barrels compared with 8,948,367 barrels for the same period last crop year.

Millfeed production amounting to 69,673 tons compared with 75,816 tons in April last year was comprised of bran 30,634 (32,394) tons, shorts 27,340 (31,987) tons and middlings 11,699 (11,435) tons, bringing the total under review for the August-April period to 610,688 tons against 646,416 tons in the same period a year ago.

Total ground feeds for April 1952 amounted to 164,526,932 pounds compared with 145,067,483 pounds in April last year. The items included in the total were as follows with comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 20,516,340 (15,887,960); Ground Oats 36,968,437 (30,371,380); Cracked Corn 7,540,239 (6,845,535); Ground Barley 23,456,250 (14,807,293); and Mixed Grain 76,045,666 (77,155,315).

NOTE: - Due to certain errors in reporting, production and stocks of Spring No. 1 or Top Patent, including Semolina have been overstated for the period January—March 1952 inclusive, while production and stocks of Spring No. 3 Patent (Strong Bakers or Export Patent) have been correspondingly understated. Revised figures appear below.




