GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production for Canadian mills reporting for the month of May 1952 exceeded the 2-million barrel mark for the first time this crop year. The output was 2,145,508 barrels against 2,095,216 barrels for the same month a year ago. This brought the total production for the August-May period of the current crop year to 18,825,366 barrels, about 6.7 per cent below that of the same period in 1950-51 when the total was 20,185,087 barrels.

Mills operating for May 1952 average 85.9 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 96,035 barrels. Mills reporting in April operated 82.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in May 1952 amounted to 9,758,260 bushels compared with 9,563,266 bushels for the same month last year. Total wheat used for flour for the ten months under review to the end of May 1952 amounted to 86,218,263 bushels while for the same ten months in the crop year 1950-51 the wheat totalled 91,040,025 bushels.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the end of May 1952 amounted to 2,090,839 bushels for flour and 143,648 bushels of feed wheat.

The production of Ontario winter wheat flour for May 1952 amounted to 76,767 barrels, bringing the total for the ten months covered to the end of May 1952 to 886,154 barrels. This was in comparison with 61,000 barrels for May last year and a total of 912,414 barrels for the August-May period in the crop year 1950-51.

May exports of wheat flour from Canada amounting to 1,197,991 barrels were down from the same month a year ago when shipments to all countries amounted to 1,483,838 barrels. In the August-May period of the current crop year exports of wheat flour totalled 9,041,348 barrels compared with 10,432,205 barrels for the corresponding period of 1950-51.

Millfeed production for May 1952 was 75,925 tons compared with 76,945 tons for the same month last year. The breakdown was bran 32,489 (30,412) tons, shorts 30,286 (33,804) tons and middlings 13,150 (12,729) tons. The cumulative total for the ten months under review this crop year was 686,613 tons compared with 723,361 tons for the same period of the previous crop year.

Ground feeds for May 1952 totalled 152,907,601 pounds compared with 142,061,138 pounds for the same month a year ago. The items included in the totals were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed wheat 17,293,300 (15,670,760); Ground Oats 37,847,111 (30,654,081); Gracked Corn 6,861,649 (9,460,128); Ground Barley 25,330,204 (18,445,082); and Mixed Grain 65,575,337 (67,831,087).


