GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour mills in Canada reporting for the month of June 1952 had an output of 2,081,788 barrels of flour compared with 2,044,118 barrels for the same month last year. The August-June total for the current crop year amounted to 20,907,154 barrels compared with 22,229,205 barrels for the same period in 1950-51.

Mill operations for June 1952 averaged 86.5 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 96,270 berrels. Mills reporting in May operated 85.9 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat processed into flour for June 1952 amounted to 9,464,843 bushels, while for the same month a year ago the amount was 9,291,364 bushels. The total amount of wheat milled for eleven months of the current crop year ending with June 1952 was 95,683,106 bushels against 100,331,389 bushels for a like period in the crop year 1950-51.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the end of June 1952 amounted to 1,635,571 bushels for flour and 145,643 bushels of feed wheat.

The production of Ontario winter wheat flour continued firm, with 84,425 barrels milled for June 1952 compared with 72,165 barrels in the same month last year. The August-June total for this grade of flour was 970,579 barrels, which compared favourably with 984,579 barrels produced in the corresponding period in 1950-51.

June exports of wheat flour recorded from returns made by Customs were the highest so far this crop year with 1,320,349 barrels going to other countries compared with a movement of 1,069,577 barrels in June last year. This brought the total exports for the eleven months under review for the current crop year to 10,428,194 barrels compared with 11,501,782 barrels for the same eleven months a year ago.

Millfeed production for June 1952 amounted to 74,162 tons compared with 75,165 tons for the same month last year. This was comprised of bran 26,359 (28,959) tons, shorts 32,410 (33,164) tons and middlings 15,393 (13,042) tons. Total millfeed production for the eleven months covered to the end of June 1952 amounted to 760,775 tons, while for the comparative period last crop year the amount was 798,526 tons.

Ground feeds for June 1952 totalisd 134,244,486 pounds compared with 133,351,777 pounds for the same month last year. The items included in the totals were as follows with the quantities in pounde and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed Wheat 17,213,900 (15,392,977); Ground Oats 33,472,482 (28,304,479); Gracked Corm 8,011,035 (10,914,316); Ground Barley 22,899,731 (17,874,308); and Mixed Grain 52,647,338 (60,865,697).
