### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The month of July 1952, with a recorded wheat flour production of 1,936,945 barrels, marked the close of the 1951-52 milling season. This was slightly above the average monthly production of 1.9 million barrels for the year. Monthly production throughout the crop year ranged from a low of 1.7 million barrels to a high of 2.1 million barrels. The usual seasonal decline in flour output was not evident this July. In July 1951 production was down to 1.4 million barrels. The total production for the crop year just ended amounted to 22,844,099 barrels against 23,630,180 barrels for 1950-51.

Mill operations for July averaged 78.1 per cent when computed on a 26-day working peried in the month and a daily capacity of 95,440 barrels. Mills reporting in June operated 86.5 per cent of their rated capacity for 25 days. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year ended July 1952 was 76.9 per cent compared with 79.8 per cent for the previous crop year.

Wheat milled for flour for July 1952 amounted to 8,838,775 bushels compared with 6,416,954 bushels milled for July last year. This brought the total wheat milled for the present crop year to 104,521,881 bushels, while for the crop year 1950-51 the total was 106,748,343 bushels. Ontario winter wheat milled for the present crop year and included in the above total amounted to 4,750,392 bushels against 4,843,895 bushels for 1950-51.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the end of July 1952 amounted to 2,162,343 bushels for flour and 130,564 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for the month of July 1952 was 69,559 barrels compared with 70,565 barrels for the same month a year ago. This brought the total production for this grade of flour to 1,040,138 barrels or about 15,000 barrels short of the total of 1,055,144 barrels for the crop year 1950-51.

Wheat flour exports for July 1952 amounted to 1,194,259 barrels compared with 925,214 barrels for the same month last year. In spite of heavy export shipments in the last half of the current crop year, total exports of 11,407,676 barrels were a million barrels lower than the total of 12,426,996 barrels recorded for 1950-51.

Millfeed production for July 1952 amounted to 69,139 tons, while for the same month a year ago the amount was 53,527 tons. This was comprised of bran 28,033 (20,138) tons, shorts 28,457 (22,233) tons and middlings 12,649 (11,156) tons. Total millfeeds for the crop year ending with July 1952 amounted to 829,914 tons compared with 852,053 tons for the previous crop year.

Ground feeds for July 1952 totalled 132,093,910 pounds against 131,509,831 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this total were as follows with the quantities in pounds and the comparative figures in brackets: Feed Wheat 16,663,860 (14,871,440); Ground Oats 34,240,580 (30,629,068); Gracked Corn 5,815,671 (9,311,168); Ground Barley 23,150,028 (21,889,905); and Mixed Grain 52,253,771 (54,808,250).
