GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

With a slight advance in wheat flour production over the previous month, Canadian flour mills opened the new crop season 1952-53 with an August output of 1,943,274 barrels compared with 1,690,885 barrels for August last year. The ten-year average production for August, based on the years 1942 to 1951, amounted to 1,899,900 barrels.

Mill operations for August averaged 77.9 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 95,895 barrels. Mills reporting in July operated 78.1 per cent of their combined rated capacity for the same number of days.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour for August 1952 amounted to 8,809,102 bushels, while for the same month last year the amount was 7,701,962 bushels. Ontario winter wheat included in this total amounted to 446,528 bushels against 588,930 bushels for August 1951.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of August 1952 amounted to 2,712,489 bushels for flour and 131,843 bushels of feed wheat.

The production of Ontario winter wheat flour for August 1952 amounting to 101,529 barrels declined from the same month a year ago when the amount was 130,856 barrels. The average monthly output for the crop year 1951-52 was 86,700 barrels.

Wheat flour exports for August 1952 were down from the previous month with 747,518 barrels recorded against 573,624 barrels for August a year ago.

Millfeeds for the month under review followed the upward trend of flour with 68,886 tons compared with 61,603 tons for the corresponding month last year. The breakdown was bran 26,276 (23,291) tons, shorts 28,912 (26,971) tons and middlings 13,698 (11,341) tons.

Ground feeds for August 1952 totalled 131,214,400 pounds, while a year ago the total for the same month was 149,167,874 pounds. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,739,240 (15,792,149); Ground Oats 33,530,863 (34,130,679); Cracked Corn 4,222,790 (8,794,836); Ground Barley 22,839,094 (25,697,256); and Mixed Grain 55,882,413 (64,752,954).


