GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Price \$1.00 a year.

Increased activity in Canadian mills for the month of September 1952 resulted in a wheat flour output of 2,120,469 barrels compared with 1,790,650 barrels for the corresponding month a year ago. Total wheat flour milled for the first two months of the current crop year amounted to 4,063,743 barrels, an increase of 582,208 barrels over the same two months in 1951-52 when the total was 3,481,535 barrels.

Mill operations for September averaged 87.8 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 96,560 barrels. Mills reporting in August operated 77.9 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in September amounted to 9,557,709 bushels against 8,141,404 bushels for the same month last year.

Ontario winter wheat included in the total for the month under review amounted to 521,396 bushels compared with 506,264 bushels for September 1951. Wheat milled for the first two months of 1952-53 totalled 18,366,811 bushels, while for the same two months of the previous crop year the amount was 15,843,366 bushels.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of September 1952 amounted to 2,847,302 bushels for flour and 207,365 bushels of feed wheat.

The production of Ontario winter wheat flour for September 1952 amounted to 116,824 barrels compared with 110,956 barrels for September last year. Ontario winter wheat flour total for the first two months of the present crop year amounted to 218,353 barrels. This was below the total of 241,812 barrels for the same two months of 1951-52.

September exports of wheat flour amounting to 1,102,225 barrels brought the total shipments for the first two months of the current crop year to 1,849,743 barrels against 1,273,852 barrels for the same two months of the last crop year.

Millfeed production recorded for September 1952 amounted to 74,769 tons against 66,372 tons for the corresponding month a year ago. This was comprised of bran 27,885 (25,078) tons, shorts 32,889 (28,780) tons and middlings 13,995 (12,514) tons. Total millfeeds for the two months under review amounted to 143,655 (127,975) tons.

Ground feeds for September 1952 totalled 154,071,410 pounds, while a year ago the total for the same month was 157,936,101 pounds. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 19,906,740 (14,712,680); Ground Oats 35,351,572 (34,207,410); Cracked Corn 7,443,697 (7,320,192); Ground Barley 22,093,859 (23,880,300); and Mixed Grain 69,275,542 (77,815,519).
